### FOR MORE INFORMATION

In 2011, DC 37 helped over 4,000 members to get over \$10 million in refunds and savings on expensive tax preparation. This year, DC 37 is continuing our partnership with Food Bank, which will operate 14 centers in all five boroughs. Centers are located near members workplaces, homes or transportation hubs. Professional tax preparers are at each site. Please use the checklist at right to be sure you bring ALL the required documents.

#### NEW INCOME LIMITS THIS YEAR.

In order to qualify for FREE electronic filing and tax preparation, a person with dependent children must have earned less than \$50,000 TOTAL FAMILY INCOME INCLUDING SPOUSE INCOME. A person with NO children must have earned less than \$18,000 TOTAL FAMILY INCOME INCLUDING SPOUSE INCOME.

#### SELF PREPARATION OPTION

For filers with incomes up to \$48,000, regardless of family size, free self-preparation with electronic filing and back up assistance of a preparer is available at three locations, see back for info.

Depending on income and family size, the member may also be eligible for the EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT, an additional amount of money that is paid to low income families in addition to their tax refund. Income limits for free tax service and the EITC are determined by the Internal Revenue Service.

#### What You Need To Bring

- Social Security cards (you **must** bring an original card, a copy of the card or a copy of last year's tax return) or ITINs; and dates of birth for yourself and all family members you are claiming.
- W-2s for **all** jobs you held in 2011 and any other tax-related documents.
- Form 1099-G, if you received unemployment insurance in 2011.
- Form 1099-INT, if you received interest from a bank account in 2011.
- If you are claiming childcare expenses, documentation of expenses and childcare agency's ID or Social Security number of provider.
- If you are filing your taxes with a spouse, you **must** bring your spouse.
- A sample check if you want direct deposit of your refund.
- 2 photo IDs (one government issued), if you wish to open a savings account and receive your refund within 7-10 days.
