

Highlights of DC 37 Economic Agreement

1. Term of Contract – 32 months and 2 days (7/1/05 – 3/2/08)
2. Wage Increases
3.15% - 1st day of 1st month (7/1/05), compounded
2% - 1st day of 14th month (8/1/06), compounded
4% - 1st day of 20th month (2/1/07), compounded.
(All additions to gross increased by across the board increases)
3. Additional Compensation Fund of .34% For Each Bargaining Unit
Available on the last day of the contract (3/2/08)
(To be used for items such as recurring increments, longevity, annuity, uniform allowance and assignment differentials)
4. Welfare Fund
\$100 per active/retiree annual rate increase to the welfare fund effective 1st day of the 13th month (7/1/06)
\$166.67 cash payment on 1st day of 17th month per active/retiree (11/1/06)
(Prorated for part-time employees – consistent with past practice)
5. Residency
Agreement to support legislation to modify the Residency restriction to allow employees to live in Nassau, Suffolk, Westchester, Orange, Rockland and Putnam Counties
6. Transit Check Program
The City's current Transit Check program shall be extended to cover LIRR, LI MTA Buses and MetroNorth transportation carriers. The parties agree to discuss further expansion of the Transit Check Program to include other regional carriers
7. Salary Review Panel
A Salary Review Panel shall be established to review selected titles and occupational groups to determine salary adjustments or other compensation modifications
8. Joint Labor Management Committee on Pension Issues
