 Box 12 (Signature) You must sign the form in blue or black ink *only*.

Step 2 Fill out the **small** part of the form **completely**. (Do not detach.)

Step 3 Mail the form to DC 37, Attn: PAL, Room 408, 125 Barclay Street, New York, NY 10007.

Step 4 DC 37 will file your form with the Board of Elections, and you will be registered to vote.

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Identification means a **verifiable New York Driver's License** number or the **last four digits of your Social Security number**, as requested in **Box 9** of your application.

If you do not have either of these, and you are registering for the first time and are doing so by mail, you may provide a copy of a valid photo ID, or a current utility bill, bank statement, government check or some other government documentation that shows your name and address. If you do not provide identification with this form, you will be asked for it the first time you vote.
