Step 4: Staffing 2 or more staff:

## **Step 1:**Patient Assessment



Patient/resident tends to have lower extremity stability, strength & control and can do the following:

- Come to a seated position & maintain balance
- Bear weight on legs & can stand
- Pivot to transfer

**Step 2:**Patient Care Tasks



- Chair to toilet
- · Bed to chair
- Bed to wheelchair
- Repositioning in bed
- Lifting of legs/arms

(depending on size of patient)

Step 3: Identify & Locate Appropriate Equipment



- Sit to Stand assist devices
- Stand Aids
- Ambulation assist devices
  - o Canes
  - Walkers
  - o Crutches
  - o Rollators
- Floor Lifts
  - Limb support
  - o Bars/handles
- Lift cushion/Lift chairs
- Lateral Transfer Aids



Size of patient and/or type of examination or medical procedure being performed may require additional staff to assist.
