DC 37 Education Fund in partnership with CUNY BMCC will provide no cost training to eligible DC 37 members. Incumbent workers will obtain IT Infrastructure Management upskilling and national industry certification to meet the growing tech demands through out the NYC government agencies.

BMCC is both a CompTIA and CISCO Authorized Training Academy for over 10 years. BMCC offers Information Technology courses for the 21st Century that provide career pathways leading to high-demand occupations.

Employment of computer and information technology occupations is projected to grow 11 percent from 2019 to 2029, much faster than the average for all occupations. These occupations are projected to add about 531,200 new jobs. Demand for these workers will stem from a greater emphasis on cloud computing, the collection and storage of data and information security. (BLS 2020)
